Janosch was born in 1931 in the Upper Silesian village of Zaborze. Before becoming a freelance artist, he worked as a blacksmith, textile pattern creator and at other jobs.

Today he is a painter, rhyme-maker, author of children's books, picture books and novels, the creator of stories and characters and the proud father of Tiger, Bear and Co. His book, *Oh, wie schön ist Panama (The Trip to Panama)*, was awarded the German Youth Literature Prize. He lives on a secluded island between the sun and the sea.

Felicitas Horstschäfer and **Johannes Vogt** live together with a few monsters in Berlin. They studied design in Münster and together they create children's books. In addition, they work as freelancers: Felicitas as illustrator for publishing houses and Johannes as exhibition designer for museums.

Monsters are hidden all over the apartment – you just have to turn the lights out and turn on the flashlight and it is time to be scared! An unusual pop-up book where readers can join in the fun.

Max lives in a normal apartment with a kitchen, bathroom and living room. Everything is in its place. Yet when the lights go off and the flashlight is switched on, gruesome shadowy creatures flit across the wall. New shadowy creatures can magically be conjured up in every room: the shy hallway monster Herbert or living-room monster Theo, who is always wailing about his in-grown toenail. Scrip and Scrap, the leftover eaters, can be found licking off the dishes in the dark kitchen, while Wanda is rowing in the bathtub... At the end there is a monster glossary, where all the familiar unfamiliar housemates are introduced.

A wonderfully droll book designed with endearing details and fabulous illustrations for children that presents a unique idea.

In October 1813, troops gather around Leipzig for the largest battle in the history of the world. When the tyrants are driven away, Joss wants to return to Siebeneichen where Maicke, the girl he has never forgotten, is hopefully awaiting him.
