Maria Montessori – untouchable?

Why the Montessori myth is crumbling

CONTENT

Maria Montessori (1870-1952) is considered by many to be the educational reformer par excellence. In educational circles, she is portrayed as a heroine and revered as such. Montessori is immune to any form of criticism of her person or work – or so it seems. Anything that does not fit the heroine profile is downplayed, concealed or tabooed. However, given a way of thinking that differentiates people according to 'racial characteristics' and 'racial types', divides them into "abnormal" and 'normal' and places education in a biopolitical context, Montessori's continued inviolability is more than questionable – both pedagogically and politically. The gap between the myth here and the educational-historical and theoretical analyses there seems to be growing ever wider.

This book provides insights into the original thinking of the Italian doctor and biologist and opens up a critical discourse instead of merely perpetuating an emotional hero worship.

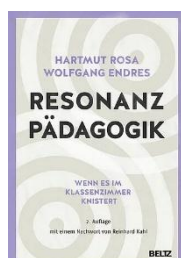

Why has the diagnosis of ADHD become so popular?

It is an attempt to explain the 'success' of ADHD. According to this theory, the transition from family to school becomes a problem for some children, as they are now required to focus their attention in an unfamiliar way on the explicit transfer of knowledge. A diagnosis of ADHD indicates that they are unable to do so. The complexity of this psychosocial problem, which is so explosive given the enormous importance of school in a person's life, is successfully reduced by medicalisation, especially since this also promises a manageable solution to the problem through psychopharmacological intervention with stimulants.

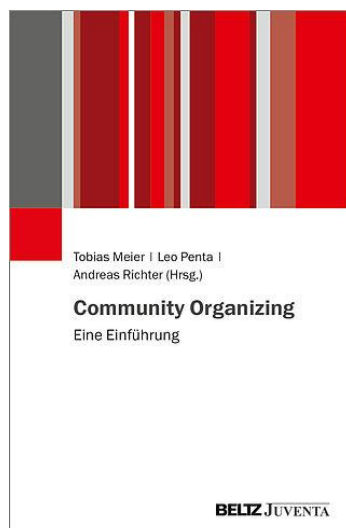
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
