

Professionelles Beziehungshandeln mit dem Kontakt-Dialog-Modell

Are these not just excuses to not connect?

Our differences are irrelevant

To only name the flaws

Are excuses to not connect. (Björk 2022)

Interaktion kann Dialog sein:

(...) interested in the person we're interacting with *as a person*. (Hycner 1993, 6, Hervorh. i. O.)

... aus Dialog kann stimmiger Kontakt werden:

(1) I am, (2) I react to you; (3) I want you to tell me who you are and what you want; and (4) I want you to tell me how you react to me. And we can look at what is not there in any contacting, and bring that into the connection. (Lichtenberg 2001, 73)

... aus stimmigem Kontakt wird (vielleicht) Begegnung:

We smiled when our eyes met. (...) I knew her experience anew, and she knew that I knew it, and I knew that I knew that she knew it. (Melnick et al. 2007, 26)

... und Beziehung bedarf professioneller Begrenzung:

Without this sense of boundary between them, (...) there can be no (...) contact. (Perls et al. 1951, 118).

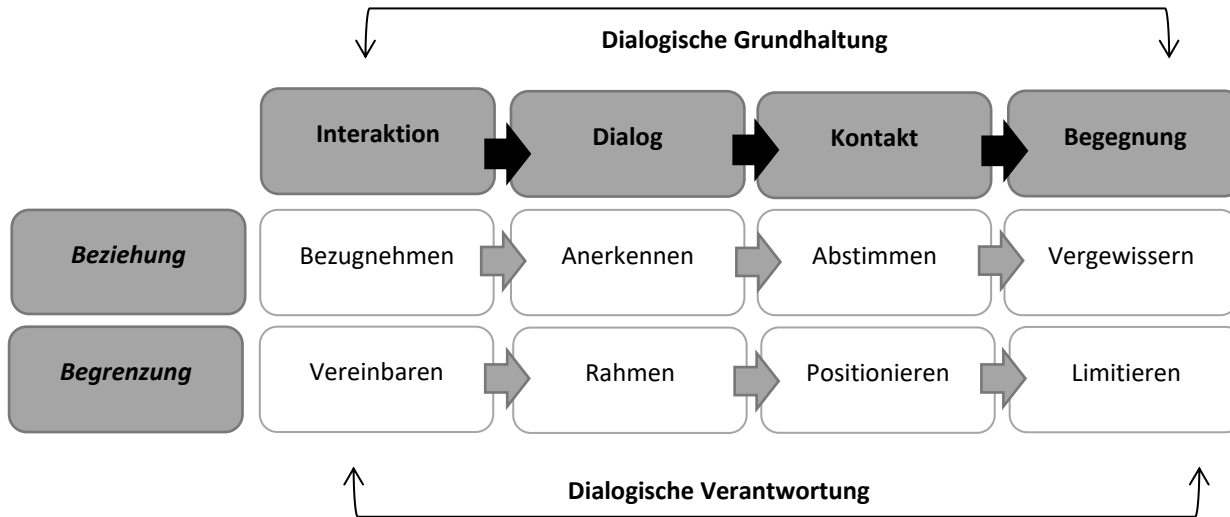
